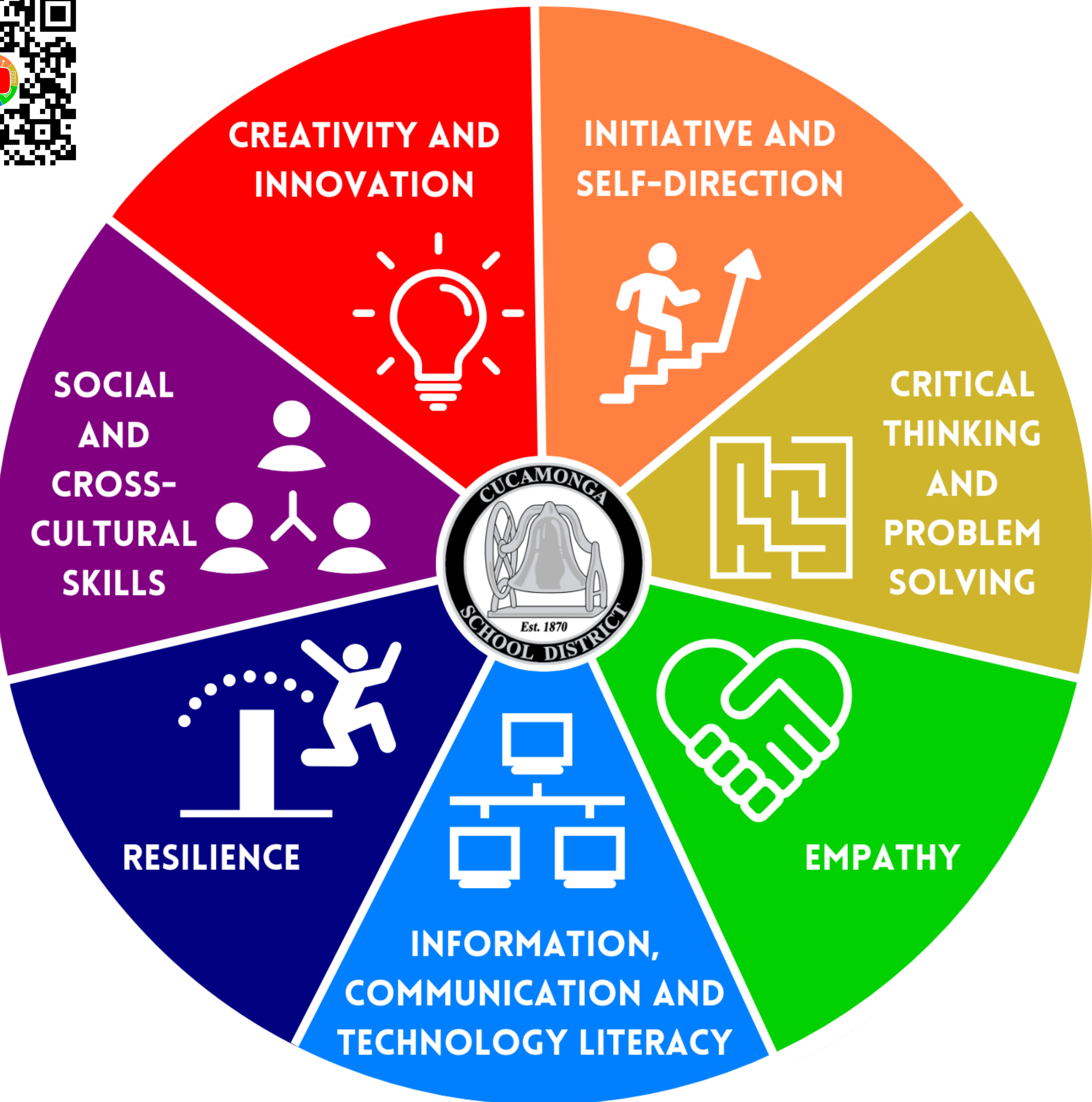

Getting along and working well with people from different backgrounds while appreciating everyone's differences

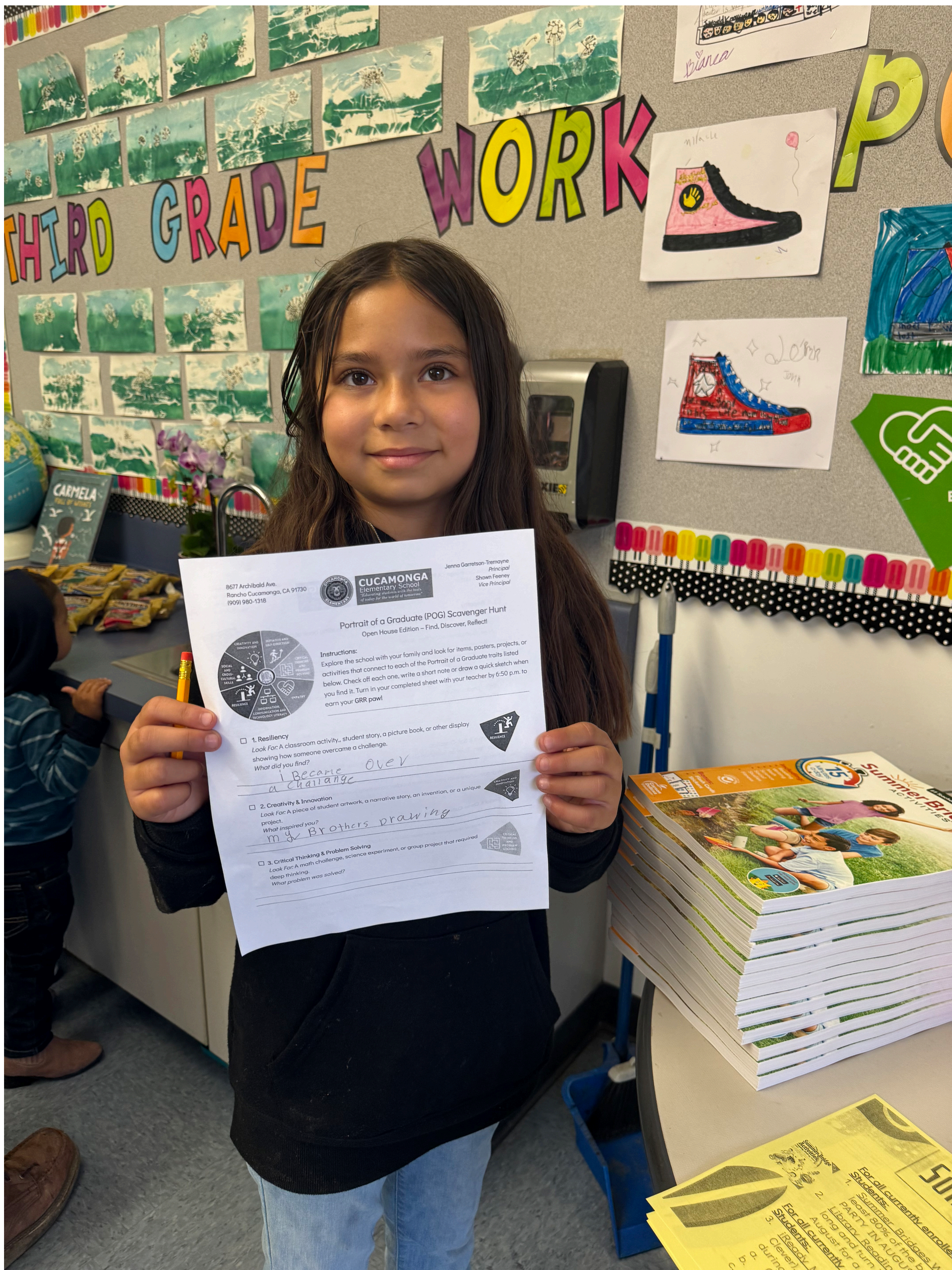
Portrait of a Graduate
