2. How can I nominate someone for the AASA Women In School Leadership Award?

Nominations must be completed online by at <http://womensleadership.aasa.org/>. Nominations must be made by September 10, 2021. The deadline for nominees to submit their applications is October 8, 2021.

3. Who is eligible to receive the AASA Women In School Leadership Award?

The AASA Women in School Leadership Award program is designed to recognize the exceptional leadership of active, front-line female leaders who are making a difference in the lives of students every day. Two awards are available:

The Superintendent Award – awarded to any female superintendent who's been in the superintendent position for two years or more.

The Central Office/Principal Award – awarded to any female central office or building level leader. Equivalent job titles may include: assistant superintendent, central office administrator, school based principal/assistant principal.

4. If I am nominated for the Women In School Leadership Award, how do I apply?

8. What is the selection criteria for the AASA Women In School Leadership Award?

Each candidate is judged on the following criteria:

- Leadership for Learning – creativity in successfully meeting the needs of students in her school or district.
- Communication – strength in both personal and organizational communication.
- Professionalism – constant improvement of administrative knowledge and skills, while providing motivation to others on the education team.
- Community Involvement – active participation in local community activities and an understanding of regional, national, and international issues.
